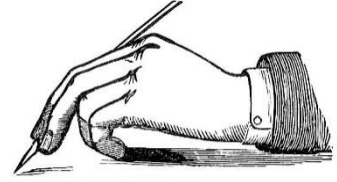

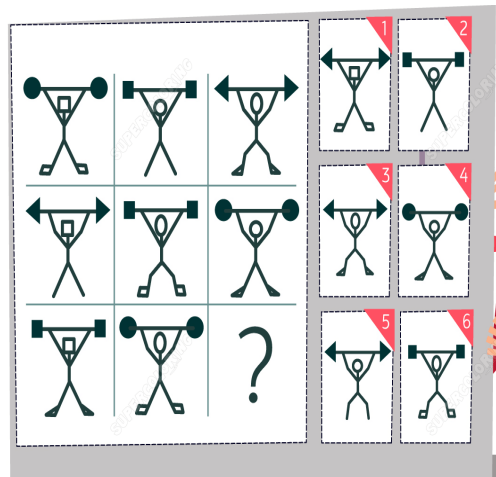
One of our students, Abhaydeep Singh, also participated in the art exhibition which was organized during the event.

Annual School Fete

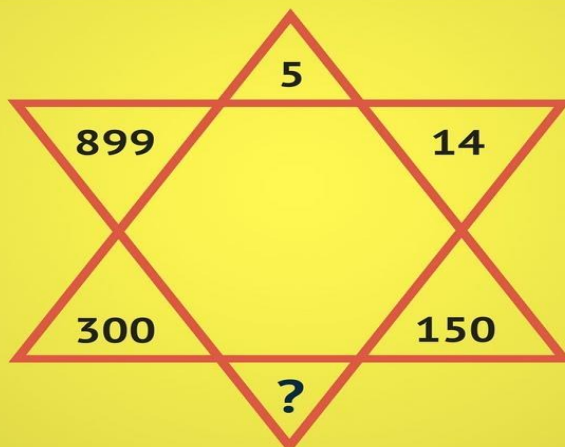


Kāsiga organised its Annual Fete on 23 October, which was a delightful socialising event for students, teachers and parents.

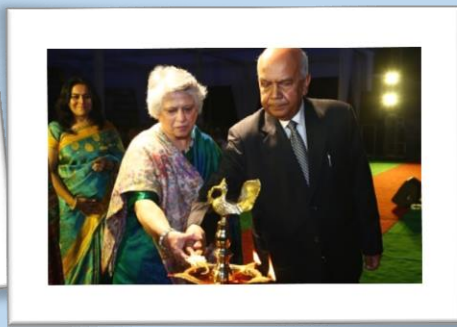
